About Our Camps

Stable Hands Summer Horse Camp is a fun and educational experience that promotes the development of life skills.

Each camp offers the opportunity to:

- Make new friends
- Enjoy both mounted and unmounted horse activities that help campers learn riding skills and horse care knowledge in a FUN and interactive environment
- Engage in various arts and crafts activities
- Get physical exercise
- Play games to keep engaged and have a blast with other campers

We have a large indoor arena, sensory trail around the property and equines of various sizes.

All sessions are guided by two highly trained facilitators in equine assisted learning that have years of horsemanship experience. They carefully match campers with an appropriate horse.

Camp Sessions

Camps are designed to accommodate children and teens ages 8+. No horse experience is necessary.

Snacks, beverages and craft materials will be provided by Stable Hands and are included in the registration cost.

Safety is our top priority. For all horse programs, we require that participants wear smooth soled shoes or boots with heels, long pants and protective helmets (ASTM/SEI helmets provided by camp).

Our summer camp is a recreational riding program and is not intended to replace formal riding lessons.

Alternative programs may be planned if weather conditions such as extreme heat or cold, rain, or wind jeopardize the safety of campers or horses.
